

**During the 2019-2020 District Grant Application period, clubs may apply for a District Grant to support Rotarian attendance at a Rotary-sponsored Project Fair. The purpose of these grants is to discover opportunities for potential International Projects. Special conditions apply:**

- If the Project Fair is in Latin America grants will be up to \$2,000 per club.
- If the Project Fair is in Africa or Asia, grants will be up to \$2,500 per club.
- A club can only apply for one District Grant and one Project Fair Grant per year.
- No more than two grants for attendance at any one Project Fair will be permitted.
- No Rotarian who was previously attended a Project Fair with District Grant sponsorship may represent a club in this District cycle.
- It is not necessary to demonstrate the required matching funds in the application.
- Funds granted may be used for registration, transportation, lodging, and meals.
- Reporting requirements will be provided when application has been submitted.

**To apply for a Project Fair Grant:**

- Login into DACdb
- Click on District – click on Grants icon – click at left on Club Grant View
- Click on top right New Club Grant Request – Click here to Create Grant
- In the Project Description box, write in your club name, name of the traveler(s), the Project Fair location and date, and amount requested.
- Save and Submit
