Assumption of the Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, provincial, and local governments and federal and provincial health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups of people.

CAMP VENTURE 2023 has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19 at its 2023 CAMP; however, CAMP VENTURE 2023 cannot guarantee that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19. What to Expect at Check-in & Registration

IMPORTANT: INFO TO BE UPDATED AS REQUIRED FOR CURRENT CONDITIONS, AS OF NOW YOU WILL NEED TO PROVIDE EITHER PROOF OF COMPLETE VACCINATION OR A NEGATIVE PCR TEST (within the last 72 hours prior to arrival)

- There is currently no mask mandate in place, but campers are encouraged to wear a mask if they wish. Please bring at least one mask with you as a precaution.
- All camp attendees are asked to **monitor their own health** seven days prior to attending camp and each morning of camp while following the CDC guidelines for protecting themselves and others.
- We will have daily health checks in accordance with the CDC guidelines.
- Curbside check-in only. No guests or family members allowed inside residence halls. Campers will be assigned a room upon arrival.

Camp Venture Rules

- 1. CAMPERS MAY NOT LEAVE THE IMMEDIATE CAMP AREA WITHOUT THE PERMISSION OF THE CAMP DIRECTOR.
- 2. CAMPERS ARE EXPECTED TO CONDUCT THEMSELVES IN THEIR ROOMS, IN SPORTS, IN THE DINING AREA AND ALL SESSIONS IN A MANNER THAT WILL BRING CREDIT TO THE CAMPER, THEIR SCHOOL, THEIR SPONSORING ROTARY CLUB AND THEIR FAMILY.
- 3. ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES ARE LIMITED TO THOSE PERIODS OF THE DAY AND EVENING SCHEDULED FOR SUCH ACTIVITIES.
- 4. ANY MEDICATIONS, WHETHER PRESCRIBED OR OVER THE COUNTER, MUST BE FULLY IDENTIFIED ON THE CONTAINER. CAMPERS FOUND IN POSSESSION OF ANY UNIDENTIFIED MEDICATIONS OR ALCOHOL WILL BE IMMEDIATELY SENT HOME, AT THE PARENTS' EXPENSE.
- APPROPRIATE ATTIRE IS REQUIRED. WALKING OR CARGO LENGTH SHORTS, NO SPANDEX OR TIGHT-FITTING PANTS, NO YOGA OR DANCE TYPE PANTS. NO UNDERWEAR SHOWING.
- 6. LIGHTS OUT AT 11:00 PM EACH NIGHT, UNLESS EXTENDED IN ADVANCE BY CAMP DIRECTORS. LIGHTS OUT MEANS THAT EVERYONE IS QUIET THEREAFTER. NO CO-ED VISITATIONS OF ROOMS AT ANY TIME.
- 7. SMOKING OR VAPING IS PROHIBITED.
- 8. CAMPERS WILL WEAR T-SHIRTS PROVIDED AT ALL TIMES (EXCEPT DURING SPORTS).
- 9. PHONE CALLS PROHIBITED UNLESS TO PARENTS OR IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY.
- 10. CAMPERS WHO DO NOT ADHERE TO THE "CAMP RULES" WILL BE SUBJECT TO DISMISSAL FROM CAMP AND MUST RETURN HOME AT PARENTS EXPENSE.





Driving Directions

From Marin, Napa, Sonoma

Take Highway 37 east and go through Vallejo

Exit onto I-80 west toward San Francisco

Exit right at Exit 29 "Maritime Academy Drive" (watch carefully for the exit - a sign is missing. It is one exit past the Magazine Street Exit). Go to the stop light at Rt. 29 Sonoma Boulevard.

Go straight across Sonoma Blvd (Hwy 29) onto Maritime Academy Drive and follow the road onto campus.

From Sacramento

Go west on I-80 toward San Francisco

Exit right at Exit 29 "Maritime Academy Drive" (watch carefully for the exit - a sign is missing. It is one exit past the Magazine Street Exit).

Go to the stop light at Rt. 29 Sonoma Boulevard.

Go straight across Sonoma Blvd (Hwy 29) onto Maritime Academy Drive and follow the road onto campus.

From San Francisco and the Peninsula

Head north on US101 toward San Francisco

Exit onto I-80 toward the Bay Bridge and Oakland

Cross the Bay Bridge and follow the signs for I-80 toward Sacramento

Cross the Carquinez Bridge (use right toll lanes). The toll is \$5.00.

Immediately after toll, exit right onto Sonoma Blvd (Hwy. 29 and Exit 29A)

Left at first stop light onto Maritime Academy Drive

Follow Maritime Academy Drive down onto campus

From Oakland

Take I-80 East toward Sacramento

Cross the Carquinez Bridge (use right toll lanes). The toll is \$5.00.

Immediately after toll, exit right onto Sonoma Blvd (Hwy. 29 and Exit 29A)

Left at first stop light onto Maritime Academy Drive

Follow Maritime Academy Drive down onto campus

From Concord, Walnut Creek, Pleasanton

North on I-680

Cross the Benicia Bridge and head West on I-780 toward Vallejo

From I-780 - Exit onto I-80 west toward San Francisco

Exit right at Exit 29 "Maritime Academy Drive" (watch carefully for the exit - a sign is missing. It is one exit past the Magazine Street Exit).

Go to the stop light at Rt. 29 Sonoma Boulevard.

Go straight across Sonoma Blvd (Hwy 29) onto Maritime Academy Drive and follow the road onto campus.
